Food for hungry families

Supplies 600 meals for a year to individuals and families who don't have enough to eat at home.



Access to food to make healthy meals.

Support 50 individuals with a weeks' worth of healthy food options from the food bank.





Crisis navigators accessible 24/7 365 days a year

Ensures trained knowledgeable crisis navigators, with access to local resource information, are always available.



Shelter a family affected by domestic violence challenges

Give a family of 4 a safe place to stay for seven days, free from violence and abuse. Shelter programs provide counseling and relocation services to help vulnerable families.





Classroom skill building and learning support for children K-3.
